RE: Changes to recycling drop off program

As of September 1st, 2009, the sites where recycling can be dropped off will be reduced to only County facilities for recycling and disposal. These sites will accept glass jars and bottles along with cans, plastic bottles, and all paper products.

The four garbage and recycling sites are:

- In Belfair on Sand Hill
- In Union on McCreavy
- In Hoodspport by Foothills Park
- and the Solid Waste Facility in Shelton on Eells Hill

These sites offer recycling during their regular hours.

In addition, Wilson Recycling on Brockdale in Shelton will also accept recyclables, including glass, along with electronics and other items. Call 462-4444 for more information.

For those not interested in drop off for recycling, at home collection is now available from Mason County Garbage, a private company. They can be reached at 1(877) 722-0223.
